

KEY FEATURES OF A FOREST SCHOOL

- The use of the natural outdoor environment.
- Child-led approach to children's learning which is fun and unhurried
- Supports personalised learning.
- Trained adults that are facilitators and observers rather than leaders and directors.
- Regular programme that allows repetition where children come into contact with nature using all their senses.
- Builds children's self-esteem and confidence as they are responsible for making their own decisions and are carefully supported to achieve.
- High adult to child ratio allows children to undertake new experiences and challenges whilst taking appropriate risks.
- Allows every child to have a voice especially those who find it difficult to communicate in a more conventional learning environment.

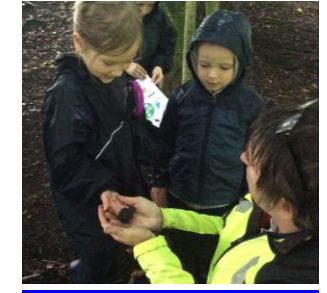
