(England) (Amendment) Regulations 2016)

### INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

- (1) The name of the Federation is **Synergy Schools**.
- (2) The names and categories of the schools in the federation are:

Name	Category
1. Brompton on Swale Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary School	Voluntary Controlled
2. Crakehall Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary School	Voluntary Controlled
3. Leeming and Londonderry Community Primary School	Community
4. Pickhill Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary School	Voluntary Controlled
5. Hutton Rudby Primary School	Community
6. Aiskew, Leeming Bar Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary School	Voluntary Controlled

- (3) The name of the Governing Body is "**The Governing Body of Synergy Schools**".
- (4) The Governing Body shall consist of:
- a) One Executive Headteacher
  - b) One Local Authority Governor
  - c) One Staff Governor
  - d) Two Parent Governors
  - e) Three Foundation Governors
  - f) Six Co-opted Governors

(5) (a) The total number of governors is fourteen.

(b) The standard term of office for all categories of governor is a fixed period of 4 years, with the exception of the staff governor which is 1 year.

(6) Foundation governors are appointed by the Diocesan Board of Education for the Diocese of Leeds.

(7) Aiskew, Leeming Bar, Brompton on Swale, Crakehall and Pickhill Church of England Voluntary Controlled Primary Schools are designated as schools having a religious character and whose ethos is derived from a Church of England Foundation:

Recognising their historic foundation, the schools will preserve and develop their religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.
